Dear Mr. Penney:

The Corps of Engineers is responsible for administering Federal laws that regulate certain activities in waters of the United States. The authority applicable to those activities is Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC 1344), which prohibits the discharge of dredged or fill material into lakes, streams or wetlands without authorization in the form of a Department of the Army permit.

It has come to my attention that the Association has been clearing and, in general, cleaning up parts of the Timber Ridge subdivision. The site is located in the NW ¼ of Section 32, Township 10 North, Range 6 East, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Based on our telephone conversation, it appears that no Section 404 activity has taken place at this time. Please be aware that a permit is required to place any type of fill material in waters of the US (streams, rivers, lakes, ponds, wetlands, etc).

I would be happy to meet with you and other members of the Association to point out jurisdictional and non-jurisdictional areas, areas to avoid and areas that present no Section 404 problems.
